 - Undergraduate Scholarship If you received an "A" average in any of the undergraduate degree years, you are eligible for a \$750 scholarship at the end of each year. In your final year of the undergraduate degree if you are continuing on to a Masters degree, you will be eligible for \$1000 instead of \$750. You must be a Nunavut resident for the period of study in which this scholarship applies.
 - Master's scholarship If you receive an "A" average in the 4th year of undergraduate degree and continue on to do Master's degree you are eligible for a \$1000 scholarship at the beginning of the 1st year of the Masters degree. If at the end of the 1st year and any subsequent years of the Masters degree you received an "A" average and you would be eligible for an additional \$1000. In your final year of the Master degree if you are continuing on to a Doctoral degree, you will be eligible for \$1500 instead of \$1000.
 - Doctorate Scholarship If you received an "A" average in the last year of a Master degree and continue on to do a Doctoral degree, you are eligible for a \$1500 scholarship at the beginning of the 1st year of the Doctoral degree. If at the end of the 1st year and any subsequent years of the Doctoral degree you receive an "A" average and you would be eligible for an additional \$1500. Students who are eligible for supplementary grant must receive a "B" average.
