The Inuit Employment and Student Support position will strengthen connections between Inuit students, the Inuit community, and community partners in Winnipeg. This role provides direct outreach and mentorship for Inuit secondary and post-secondary students, supports community members with employment readiness, and helps deliver cultural and educational programming.

Duties and responsibilities:

- Provide outreach, mentorship, and support to Inuit students in high schools, colleges, and universities.
- Assist with job search support, resume building, and connecting Inuit community members with training and employment opportunities.
- Organize and deliver mentorship programs, cultural activities, and student/community engagement events.
- Build partnerships with schools, community organizations, and agencies.
- Support Inuit artists and talent by coordinating opportunities at craft and cultural events.
- Assist with recruitment of IAM membership and provide administrative support to programs.

Qualifications:

Inuk preferred;

- Experience working with Inuit or Indigenous communities.
- Knowledge of Inuit culture, language, and traditions.
- Experience in outreach, student support, or employment programming.
- Strong communication and relationship-building skills.
- Basic computer skills (Microsoft Office); Inuktitut fluency is an asset.
- Flexibility to work evenings and weekends when needed.
